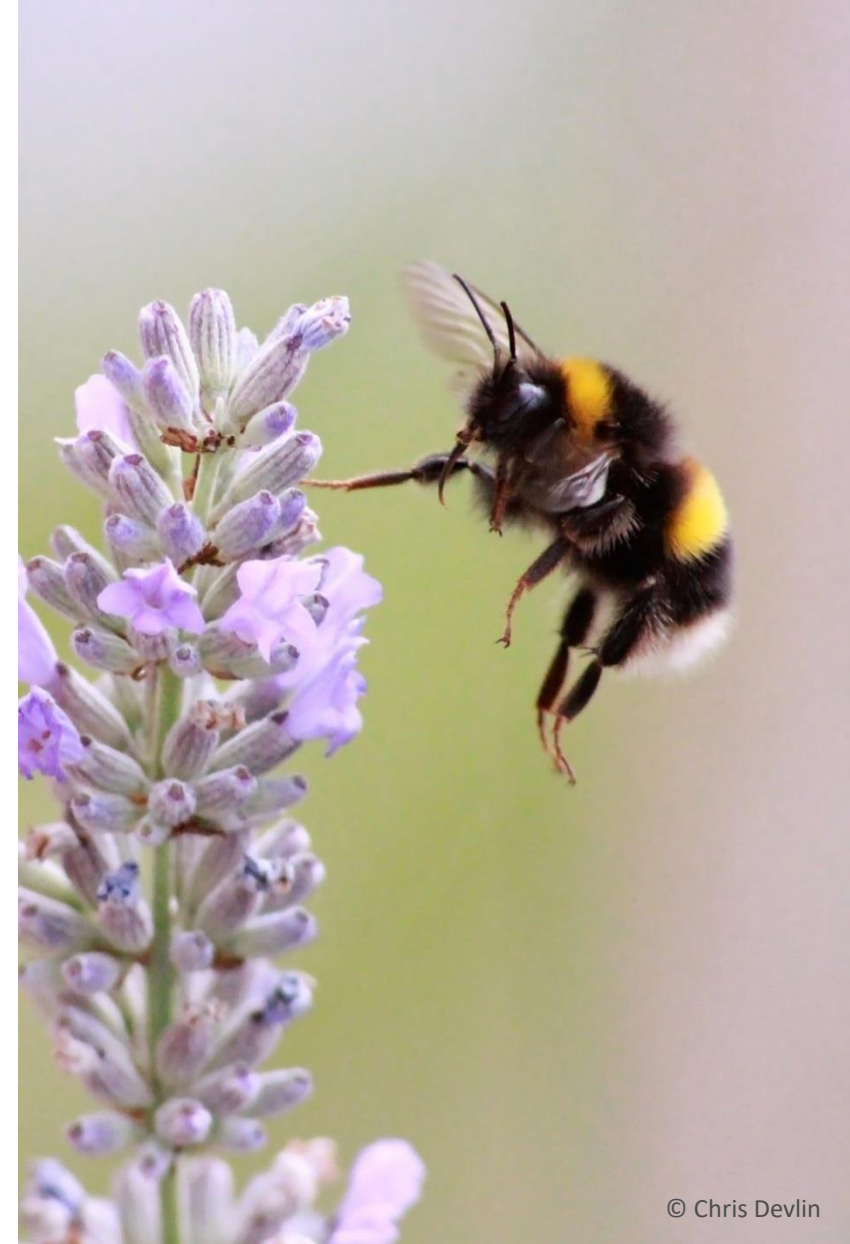

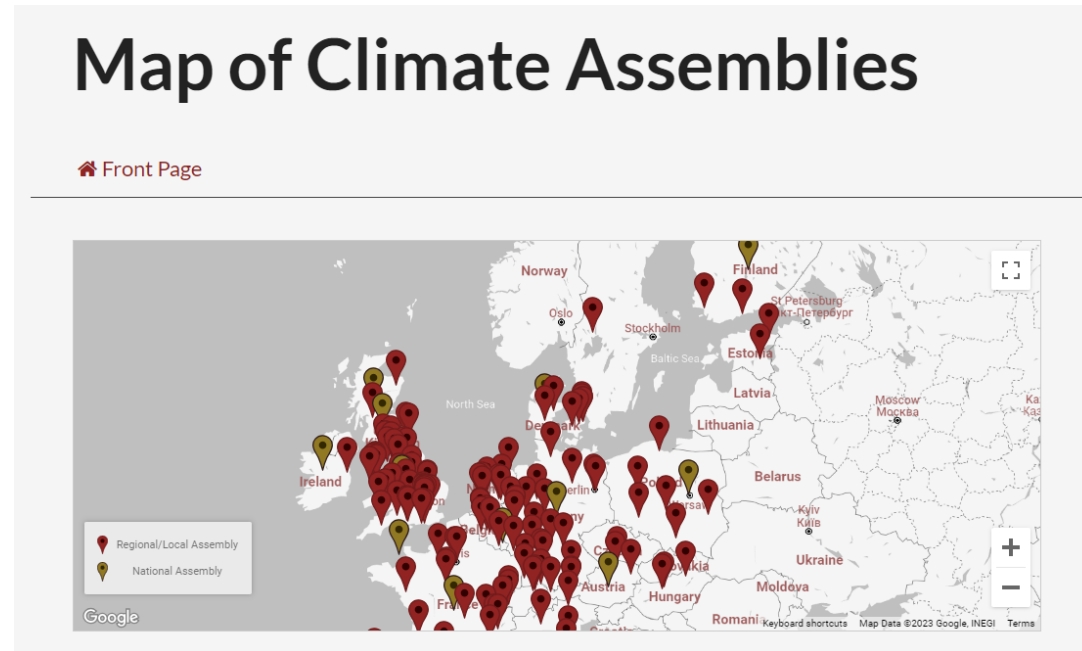
- Democratic participation beyond elections

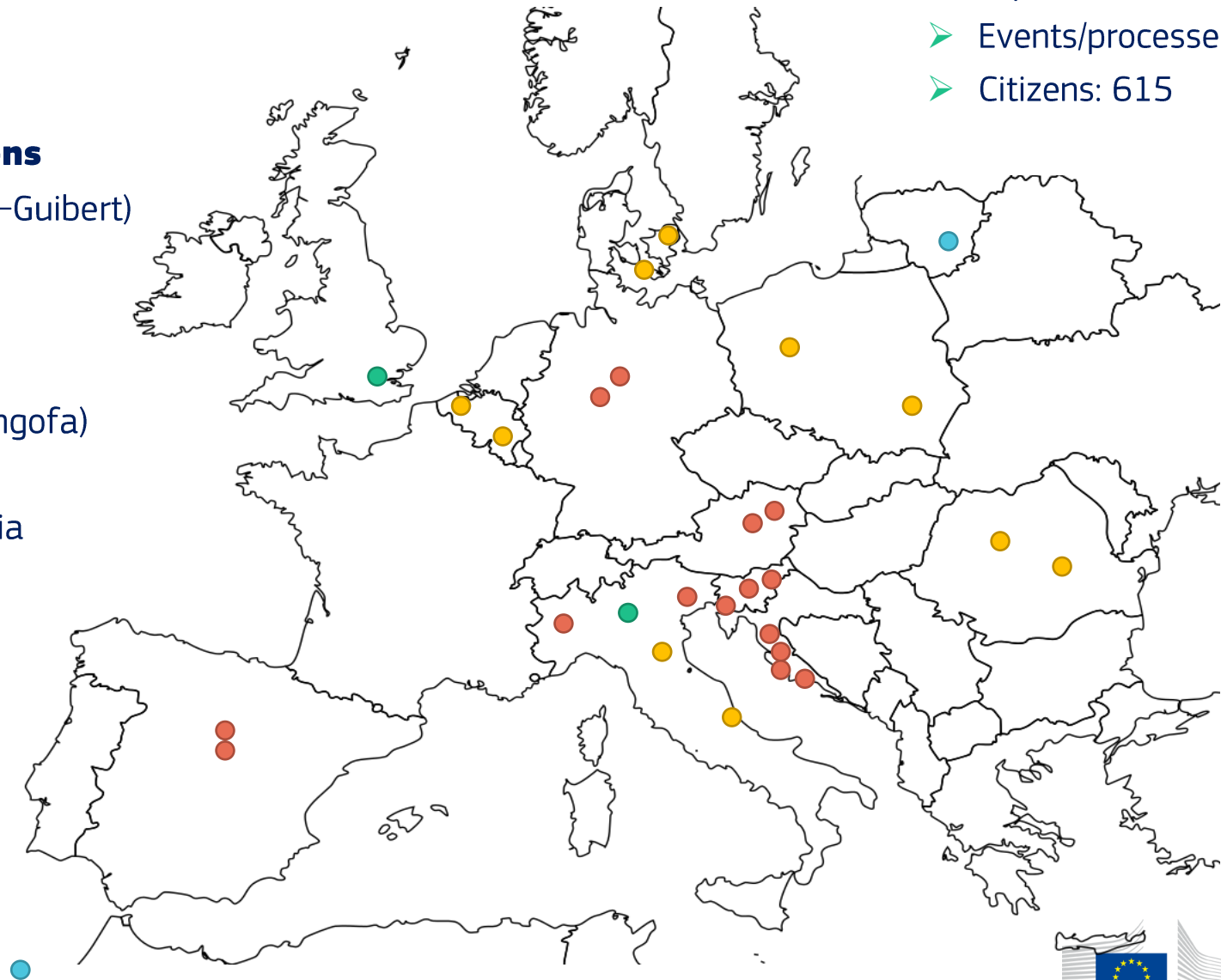
